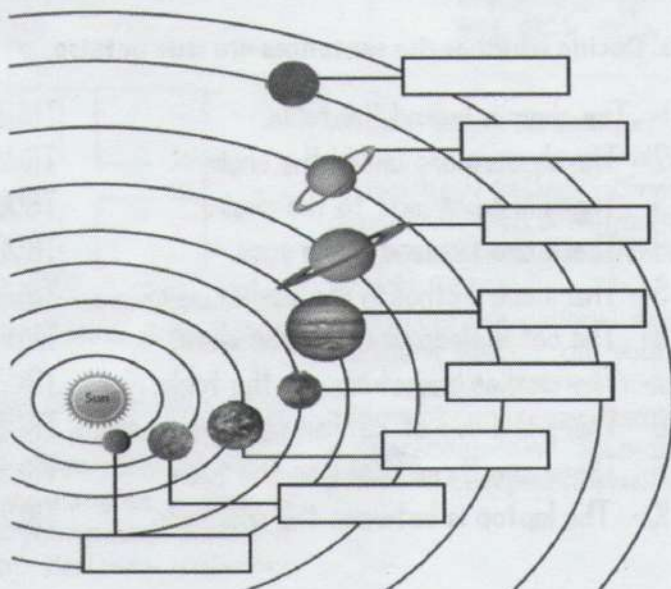

XVI. Read the text about famous monuments of Chita and guess.

The **Monument to the Heroes** of the Civil War represents the soldier of Red Army with a rifle in his right hand, the worker with a rifle, too and the red peasant partisan between them. They are 6,5 meters high. The monument reminds of the bloody war against white guards and interventionists in 1918-1920.

The **Monument at the foot of the Titov Hill** pays tribute to the revolutionaries of 1905-1907. The revolutionaries Stolyarov, Kostyushko-Grigorovich and others were shot at the foot of the hill by gendarmes in 1906. There is an obelisk decorated with bas-reliefs representing the portraits of the revolutionaries.

Every year on May, 9 people in Chita go to celebrate Victory Day to the **Memorial Complex** which was opened on the territory of Victory Park. The names of soldiers from Zabaikalye who died for freedom of our country during the Great Patriotic War are written on stone walls of the Memorial. The magnificent group sculpture symbolizes the unity of the front, the rear and the partisan movement. There is the Eternal Flame where people revere the memory of all the fallen.
